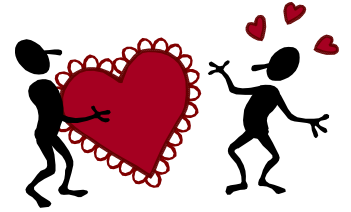

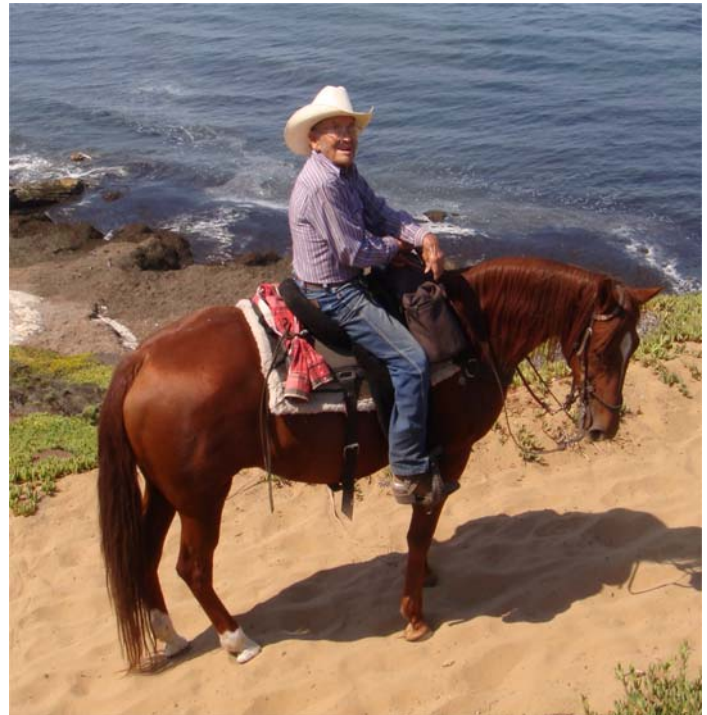


# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This gives you time to saddle up, sign in and be in the saddle ten minutes before departure time.

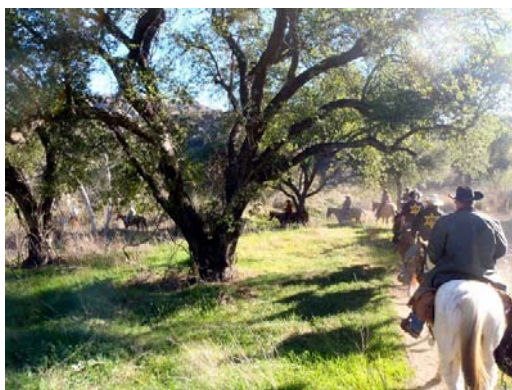

## Tad Williams Memorial Ride 2012

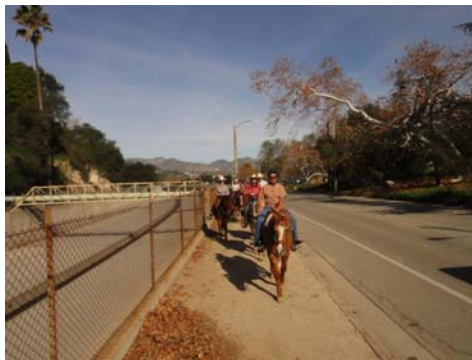

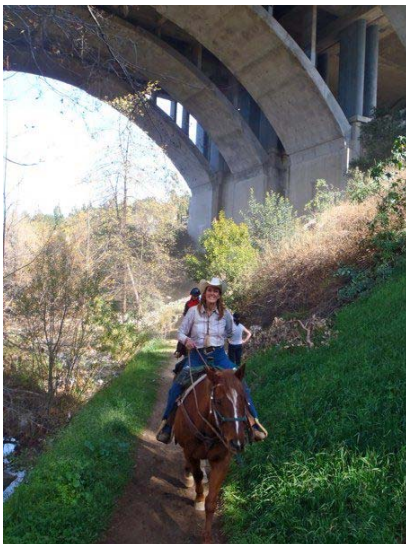

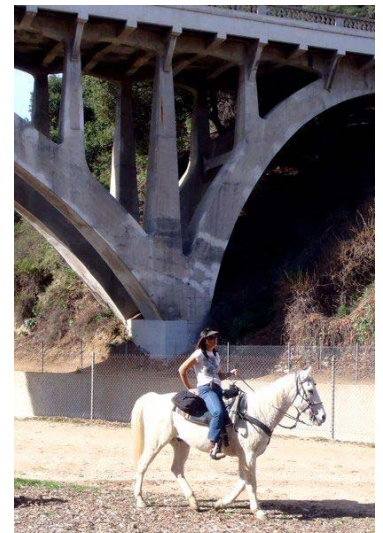

# Historian's Corner

## Historian's Corner Part# 18

In 1981 the Corral board meetings were still being held a week before the general meeting discussing the topics that were talked about at the general membership meeting. The monthly bulletin now included free classified ads as well as lots of info on other ETI Corral functions which made it possible for members to ride every weekend with some months having as many as 4 scheduled Corral rides not including events put on by ETI National. Along with the Corral officers terms starting in January, each Corral was now responsible for paying their club insurance by the first of the year.

During this period of time Corral 22 was encouraged to write letters to Congressman Carlos Moorhead regarding concerns about the Lightening Point Project not being completed after over a half million dollars had been already spent. There was still no water and money Corral 22 and Corral 10 donated for corrals at the facility had not been installed.

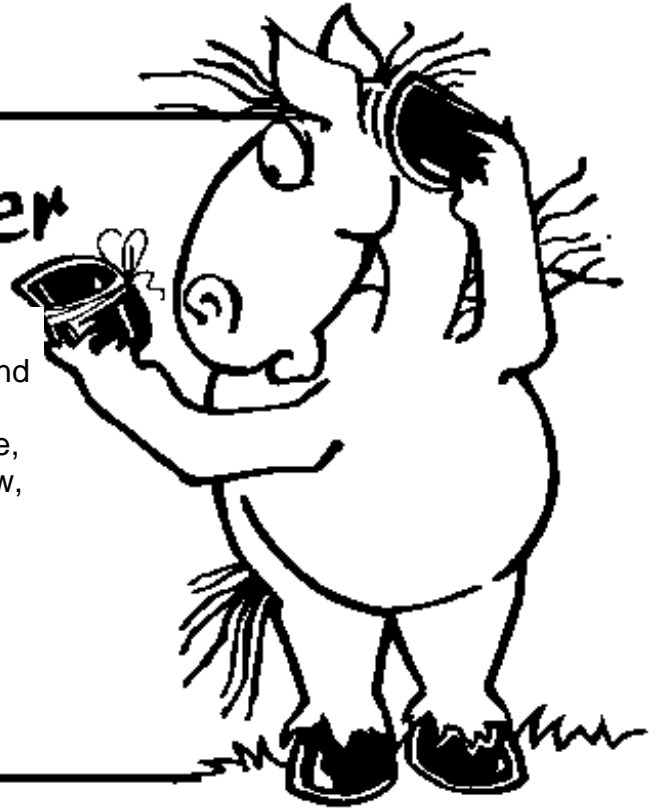
Corral 22 was still enjoying the out of area rides even though it took lots of planning, coordination and effort to do these rides. John's Horse Camp, Yosemite, Anza Borrego and Palm Springs always made it worthwhile. Cal Plum, our Area Director stressed the importance of documenting all rides, local or long distance to the newly formed "Trail Rider Awards Program" TRAP for short. This new program not only recognized your riding hours on the trails but would also give ETI National great documented records of trail usage especially when local officials were trying to eliminate equestrian areas for city expansion and development.

In all the years of Corral 22 being an exclusive trail riding group, there had never been a trail trials competition until now. In October of '81 the Corral held its first trials. There would be a trophy for the "best darn trail horse" winner and ribbons for the 10 top riders. Vasquez Rocks County Park in Agua Duke was chosen as the best place to hold the competition and it would be open to all ETI.

After several years of hard work to open county flood control channels in Sylmar, Wilson Canyon Trail through Olive View Hospital grounds became a reality in December of '81. This was one of the first projects funded from the Los Angeles City Horse Tax funds.

# ETI CORRAL 22 CHINO HILLS STATE PARK FEBRUARY 3, 4 & 5

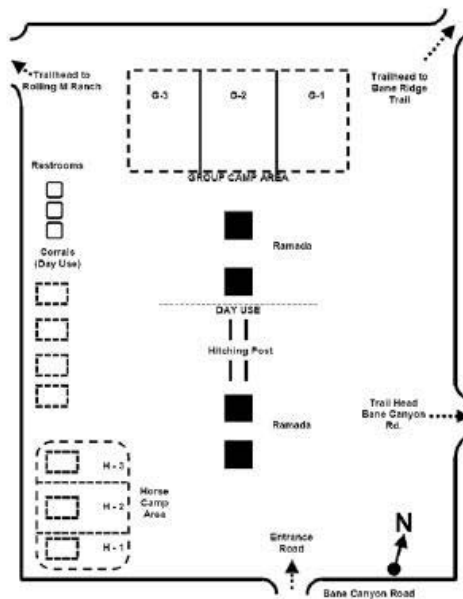

Arrive anytime between 1:00PM and 5:00PM Friday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Entrance gate is locked after 5:00PM. There are a few corrals left; Plenty of room for portable corrals. Water is available but we will need plenty of hose to reach the corrals. There are portable toilets but no showers. Cost is \$15.00 per person for the ride. PLEASE call or email Sharon with your reservation by February 1st. There will be a potluck on Saturday night; Call Sharon to find out what is needed for the potluck.



Chino Hills State Park can be a bit tricky to find. The park is located west of Highway 71 between the Riverside Freeway (91) and the Pomona Freeway (60). From the Riverside Freeway (91) in Corona, go north on Highway 71 for 8 miles and exit on Soquel Canyon Parkway. Make a left, proceed to Elvinar Road, turn left and proceed through a residential area (Watch for a State Park sign on the left side of Soquel Canyon Parkway just before Elvinar; Turning right at this intersection will put you onto Cypress Point - DO NOT TURN RIGHT). Just after Elvinar turns east and becomes Sapphire Road, you'll see the signed Chino Hills State Park dirt entrance road on your right. (This park entry road is closed for a period of 48 hours after a rainstorm.) Enter the park on this dirt road (which returns to pavement in 1.5 miles). The horse camp is 2.8 miles from the Sapphire Road entrance.

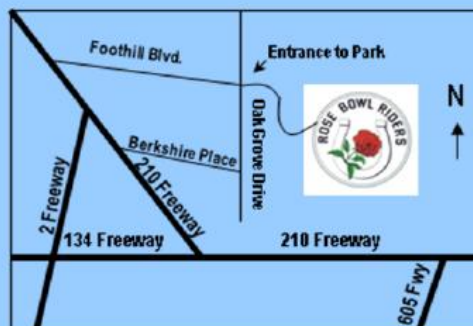

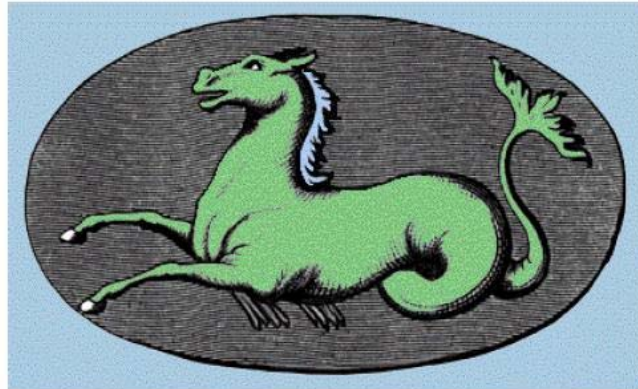

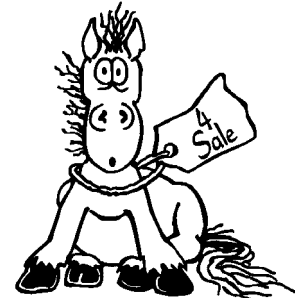
